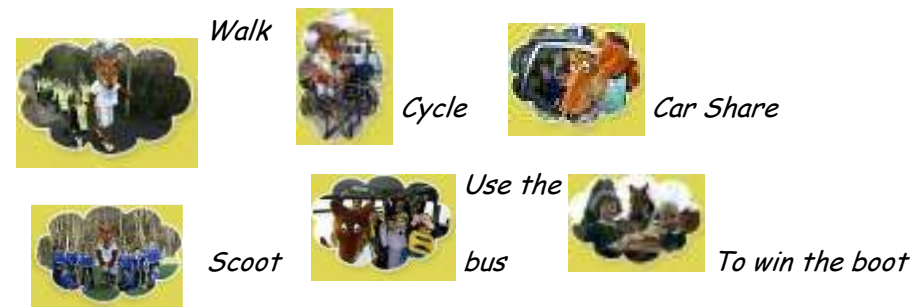

We will once again be taking part in the Golden boot challenge. First launched in 2002, the Golden Boot Challenge is part of Surrey County Council's Safe Routes to Schools initiative and this year's campaign is anticipated to be the biggest and the best yet. Pupils score points when they:



Over the four-week campaign during June (every Friday), We collect the information, use it to make a detailed analysis of all the modes of transport used, with the results sent back to the county. The class in school with the most points wins the coveted Golden Boot trophy. Please try and support the children on a Friday by using a different mode of transport when coming to school.
